Sub : Revision of incentive to the Small and Medium Red Category industries confirming to ISO 14001 standards – reg.

The Board in its 147<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27.09.2002 had resolved to pay incentive of Rs.35,000/- to Medium and Small Red Category industries who get certification of ISO:14001 standard. Accordingly, OM was issued vide reference (1). Information regarding this incentive is published in the Citizen Charter.

In 210<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Board noted that ISO certification will improve the compliance level of Medium and Small Red Category industries who voluntarily obtain the latest ISO 14001 Environmental Management System Certification and also approved to increase the incentive from Rs.35,000/- to Rs.50,000/-. Hence the following order.

ORDER

1. Medium and Small Red Category industries adopting ISO 14001:2015 standards will be given Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand rupees only) as incentive.
2. This incentive shall be sanctioned to the Small and Medium Red Category industries who have adopted the ISO 14001:2015 for Environment Management System with effect from January, 2017.
3. The definition of Small Scale, Medium Scale is based on Capital Investment definition prescribed under Rule 32 of the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (Procedure for Transaction of Business) and the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1976.
4. The incentive is for only Small and Medium Red Category units (Small scale investment – Rs.25 lakhs to Rs.5 Crore, Medium Scale investment – Rs.5-10 Crore).

The Medium and Small Red Category industries shall submit an application with all the details to the Board for availing this benefit. The concerned Regional Officer shall verify the application and documents and send the recommendation to Head Office.
