OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Simplification of procedures regarding renewal of Consent for Operation under the provisions of Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 - reg.

<*><*><*>

The number of applications being received by the Board under the pollution control laws is increasing year after year and therefore the workload on the Board has also increased manifold. Processing and disposal of applications is consuming considerable time and efforts of the officers of the Board. There has been repeated representation from both industries and industry associations to reduce the paper work and to expedite the consent application disposal mechanism. Even the State Government has enacted a law (SAKALA) to fix time limits to various services of the State. The Board has its own Citizen Charter wherein voluntary time limits have been specified to dispose of the applications. Moreover, the Board has prepared a Results Frame Work Document (RFD) 2012-13 wherein commitments have been made for effective implementation of pollution control laws. Further, the CAG in its performance review report has made observations related to consent administration. The Board in its 175th meeting discussed the issue and approved simplification of procedures for speedy disposal of applications and the same was reemphasized in the 185th Board meeting held on 9.10.2012.

In this background and in order to reduce the paper work, time taken for processing and disposal of applications and to utilize the time so saved for effective monitoring of polluting activities and to concentrate on other core activities of Board the following procedures are prescribed for issue of Consent for Operations;

Validity of Consent for Operation (CFO) issued earlier by the Board under the Water Act and Air Act shall be extended on receipt of following documents from the organization/industry before expiry of the validity period.

- 1) Request letter as per Annexure -I (copy enclosed) duly signed by the occupier.
- 2) Prescribed consent fees in the form of DD.
- 3) Certificate of Capital Investment as per Annexure - II (copy enclosed).
- 4) Copy of the previous valid consent order with annexure.

The validity extension of CFOs shall be indicated in the acknowledgement slip itself.

This order does not apply to organizations/industries, operations or processes where:-

- a) Matters relating to earlier consent is pending before the Appellate Authority or any other Court; or
- b) whose immediate preceding application has been refused; or
- c) where directions under 33A & 31A are in force or prohibitory orders under Water Act is in force or where issuance is recommended for such orders; or
- d) any mining activity; or to any stone crushers.

CFOs which can not be processed because of the above four reasons shall be processed in the same manner as is being followed at present.

CFO renewal applications already received and pending at Regional Offices and at Head Office shall be disposed off as per the revised simple procedure provided the applications meets the required criteria without insisting for copy of the previous valid consent order since the concerned office will be having it already.

The Board reserves the right to review such validity extension of CFOs at any time. The ROs shall bring to the notice of all cases where CFO conditions have to be modified or altered to the HO to make it more effective.

The Regional Officers shall maintain a list of non eligible industries/organizations for this simplified procedure and update the same on a day to day basis.

This order will come into force with effect from 26.11.2012.

Sub: Regarding renewal of consent for operation.

Ref: Board Office Memorandum No.PCB/167/CC/2012/4984 dated 21/11/2012.

In the consent letters being issued under Water and Air Act, a condition is stipulated that the applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent atleast 120 days before the expiry date. Consequent to introduction of simplified procedure for renewal applications for Consent for Operation (CFO) under Water and Air Acts may be accepted during the periods indicated below.

- 1) For CFO applications valid upto 30th June – applications shall be received from 1st June.
- 2) For CFO applications valid upto 30th September – applications shall be received 1st September.
- 3) For CFO applications valid upto 31st December – applications shall be received from 1st December.

It is clarified that, the simplified procedure of renewing CFO across the counter is applicable only for such industries/organizations which meets the criteria specified in the Office Memorandum cited at reference.
