Preamble:

One of the functions of the State Board under Water and Air Acts is to plan for Prevention, Control or abatement of Air and Water pollution in the State. Further, growing environmental challenges require innovative R & D efforts. The Board has established Central Environmental Lab at Bengaluru which is equipped with latest equipments for analysis of Air, Water effluent samples. The Central Environmental Laboratory is ISO 45001:2018 Occupational health Safety management system Certificated and accredited for ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standard from National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration of Laboratories.

In this regard, the Board to encourage R & D activities on pollution, prevention and control, Central Environmental Lab of the Board is recognized as R & D Centre by Visveswaraya Technological University (VTU).
