At the outset, Sri M.S.Natesh, Member Convener of the LAC and Environmental Officer, Regional Office, KSPCB, Raichur welcomed the Chairman of the Committee, Members of the Committee, Special Invitees and requested retired Prof. Ravindra Kadagad, Chairman of the Committee to Chair the meeting.

The following subjects and issues were discussed.

Subject 1: Read and confirmation of proceedings of the 5 th LAC meeting

The proceedings of the Fifth Meeting of the Local Area Committee held on 27.07.2022 was read and confirmed.

Subject 2: Fixing of Revised Time Lines under the SEPI Action Plan..

The Member convener, brought to the notice of the committee regarding review of implementation of the CEPI Action points by the Member Secretary, CPCB in the meeting held on 10.10.2022. As per which, revised action plan along with revised time lines has to be submitted as the present time lines have expired.

Smt. Anjana Kumari, RD, CPCB, advised that, the revised time lines have to be set after obtaining the confirmation from the concerned implementation departments, i.e., KIADB, RTPS, YTPS etc. The Member convener agreed to obtain the confirmation from the concerned departments/organizations for revising the time lines.

Subject 3: Restoration of Polluted Water bodies/contaminated sites/ground water in the jurisdiction of CPA/SPA/OPA.

The Member convener informed that there are no declared Polluted Water bodies/contaminated sites/ ground water points in the Raichur Growth Center OPI Area. Hence, this point is not applicable.

Subject 4: Installation of Continuous Water quality monitoring stations as per the directions issued by the CPCB on 26.04.2016 in case of CPA/SPA/OPA.

The Member convener, stated that one continuous water Quality Monitoring Station has already been established in the year 2017 in River Krishna behind the RTPS plant coming under the Raichur Growth Center OPI Area and same is under operation and hence this point is complied.

Subject 5: Continuous Surveillance Monitoring of sewage/effluent discharge into lakes in CPA/SPA/OPA.

The Member Convener informed that there are no lakes under the Raichur Growth Center OPI Area. Hence this point is not applicable for the said area.

Subject 5: Carrying out source apportionment study for further planning of pollution control. This study may be carried out in house.

The Member Convener informed that, Raichur Growth Center comes under Other Polluted Area (OPI) and sought clarification from the CPCB representative on conducting of the source apportionment study.

Smt. Anjana Kumari, RD, CPCB, replied that though the source apportionment study is applicable in case of Critically Polluted Areas (CPA)'s, considering the presence of RTPS and YTPS, which are significant from the air pollution control point of the view, she suggested to conduct the source apportionment study through reputed agencies like TERI, Bengaluru, which are already involved in conduct of such studies in other cities.

The Member convener agreed to initiate the source apportionment study through the reputed agencies after following the due procedure.

The Chairman, LAC directed the concerned departments/organizations to immediately revise the time lines in implementation of agenda points as per the CPCB direction based on minimum time required.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chairman, Members and Invitees present in the meeting.
