

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF SHRI. RAMAPPA. Y. SULLANAVAR, SY. NO. 129/1, 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6, HEBBALI VILLAGE, BADAMI TALUK & BAGALKOT DISTRICT, HAS PROPOSED TO UNDERTAKE MINING OF ORDINARY SAND OF CAPACITY 49,948TPA IN AN MINE LEASE AREA OF 9.14 ACRES HELD ON 24/08/2021 AT 11.00AM AT PROJECT SITE, HEBBALI VILLAGE, BADAMI TALUK & BAGALKOT DISTRICT.

Shri Rajshekhar. Puranik., Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Bagalkote extended a warm welcome to the Additional Deputy Commissioner & Chairman, Environmental Public Hearing Committee, Bagalkote District, the Senior Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Dharwad and all the participating villagers from surrounding area & public, elected representatives who were present in the public hearing. Further, he briefly explained the needs for Environmental Clearance and public hearing for the said project as follows:

Shri. Ramappa Y Sullanavar, propose to undertake Mining of Ordinary Sand of capacity 49,948TPA in an Mine lease area of 9.14 Acre at Sy. No. 129/1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Hebbali village, Badami Taluk & Bagalkot District.

As per the Environmental Impact Assessment Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India on 14.09.2006 (Amendment Notification on 01-12-2009), it is a prerequisite to get Environmental Clearance from the State Level Impact Assessment Authority, GOK and Conducting Environmental Public Hearing for the said project.

As per the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (IA Division), GOI, the project proponent has made application for Environmental Clearance and got the Terms of Reference from State Level Impact Assessment Authority, GOK vide Letter dated: 28-08-2020 and accordingly the draft EIA report is prepared. The project proponent submitted the request letter to the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board, Bangalore for conducting the public hearing. Accordingly, with the concurrence of the Deputy Commissioner, Bagalkote, the Public Hearing is scheduled on 24-08-2021 at Project site, Hebbali village, Badami Taluk & Bagalkot District.

As per the EIA Notification, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board gave the Paper Notification 30 days in advance in the Kannada Daily Newspaper "Uday Vani" and English Daily Newspaper "The Times of India" dated: 24-07-2021 and in local daily Kannada Newspaper "Sanje Darshan" on 27-07-2021. In the said Notification, the suggestions / views/ comments and objections of the interested bonafide residents, Environmental groups and others located near the project site and are likely to be affected by the proposed project were given opportunity to send their suggestions, objections, grievances, etc. in written or through E-mail to the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board/Chairman, Environment Public Hearing Committee, within 30 days from the date of publication of the notification.

The copy of the draft EIA report and Executive summary of the EIA report both in Kannada and English were placed at the following places for the references of the general public.

The Regional office KSPCB, Bagalkote and other offices mentioned above have not received any E-mail or any written applications with comments or objections from public as on 23-08-2021 in respect of said project. This Environmental Public Hearing is organized for hearing the suggestions/ views/ comments and objections of the interested public and villagers on Environmental related issues.

He informed the representatives of the Environmental Consultant, M/s. Horizon Ventures, Bengaluru to make a Power Point Presentation on environment study conducted on Air, Water, Soil & noise environmental impact assessment and the environmental management plan of the proposed project to the public gathered;

On behalf of M/s. Horizon Ventures, Bengaluru, the Environmental Consultant Shri. Sachin M U, made the Power Point Presentation. He explained about the objectives of the proposed project, the Environmental base line data and present scenario of existing environment in the project area. The impacts of the project on the environment, The Environment Management Plan and measures proposed to control/ mitigate the Environmental Pollution and its protection, environmental monitoring etc by the Project Proponent. The hard copy of the presentations made in the public Hearing is enclosed with this proceeding, as Annexure-01. List of participants/villagers & others who attended the Public Hearing is enclosed as Annexure-02.

Shri. Vijaykumar T. Kadakbhavi, The Senior Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Zonal Office, Dharwad addressed the public hearing as follows:

- He informed to public present in the hearing that, the Regional Officer, RO, KSPCB, Bagalkote has already explained the purpose of conducting the public hearing.
- The Environmental Consultant of M/s. Horizon Ventures, Bengaluru has prepared draft EIA report and was submitted to State Level Impact Assessment Authority, GOK and Terms of Reference from State Level Impact Assessment Authority, GOK vide Letter dated: 28-08-2020.
- As per the EIA Notification, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board gave the Paper Notification 30 days in advance.
- The copy of the draft EIA report and Executive summary of the EIA report both in Kannada and English were placed at above places and Web site of KSPCB <http://kspcb.gov.in> for the references of the general public.
- Already, Shri. Sachin M U of M/s. Horizon Ventures, Bengaluru made the Power Point Presentation and explained about the objectives of the proposed project, the Environmental base line data and present scenario of existing environment in the project area. The impacts of the project on the environment, The Environment Management Plan and measures proposed to control/ mitigate the Environmental Pollution and its protection, environmental monitoring etc by the Project Proponent. But, they are outsiders and new to Hebbali village and public present in the public hearing are nearby villagers to project site. Hence, you know more about the

surrounding environment and animal life etc.

- In view of the above, he requested public to raise query/ suggestion regarding environmental issues and pollution control measures proposed by the Project Proponents for the said project.

The Environmental Officer requested the public & villagers present in the hearing to express their suggestions / views / comments if any about the said project. Accordingly the following villagers/public are expressed their views in the hearing:

**1. Shree. Mahadevagouda S Iranagoudar of Hebballi Village.**

- He informed that, the authorities should create job opportunities to surrounding villagers in proposed Ordinary Sand Mining project.
- The Mine authorities should carry out the mining activity as per the guidelines/ norms/ conditions/ directions/ standards stipulated by the competent authorities.
- In view of the above, he extended his support for undertaking the proposed sand mining project for benefit of the public.

**2. Shree. Suresh B Badadeli of Hebballi Village**

- He informed the mine authorities should take care that, the surrounding villagers should not face any problems from the proposed Ordinary sand mining project and extended his support for undertaking the proposed project.

**3. Shree. Hanumantappa B Khavast of Hebballi Village**

- He informed, that, the sand mine authorities should not overload the vehicles and maintain speed limit of vehicles in the village limits.
- Hence, he extended his support for undertaking the proposed Ordinary sand mining project.

**4. Shree. Ninganagouda S Iranagoudar of Hebballi Village**

- He informed that, the sand mine authorities should not overload the vehicles and maintain speed limit of vehicles in the village limits as the students & animals are moving on roads.
- Hence, he extended his support for undertaking the proposed Ordinary sand mining project.

**5. Shree. Satish Maruti Katagi of Hebballi Village**

- He informed the mine authorities should take care that, the surrounding villagers should not face any problems from the proposed Ordinary sand mining project.
- The sand mine authorities should not overload the vehicles, maintain speed limit of vehicles and also should not create traffic in surrounding villages.
- Hence, he is extending his support for proposed project.

**Shri. Vijaykumar T. Kadakhavi, The Senior Environmental Officer, KSPCB, Zonal Office, Dharwad informed the Project authorities and Environmental Consultant as follows:**

1. He informed the Mining authorities to give clarification on job opportunities to surrounding villagers in proposed Ordinary Sand Mining project.
2. Also, he informed the Mining authorities to give clarification to the public query regarding overloading of the vehicles and maintaining speed limit of vehicles in the village limits.

**Clarification by Shree. Ramappa Y Sullanavar, Mine Owner is as follows:**

He informed in the public hearing that, He will comply to all the points mentioned in presentation made by the Environmental Consultant and also, they will operate the proposed ordinary sand mine compliance to the Rules & Regulations.


**Shri Mahadev A Muragi, the Additional Deputy Commissioner and Chairman of the Public Hearing Committee, Bagalkote District addressed the public hearing as follows:**

- Already the Environmental Consultant Shri. Sachin M-U of M/s. Horizon Ventures, Bengaluru made the Power Point Presentation. He explained about the objectives of the proposed project, the Environmental base line data and present scenario of existing environment in the project area. The impacts of the project on the environment, The Environment Management Plan and measures proposed to control/ mitigate the Environmental Pollution and its protection; environmental monitoring etc.
- The villagers present in the public hearing expressed that, there will not be any environmental related problems and shown their support to proposed sand mining project.
- The mine authorities should not overload any vehicles during transportation of sand as it will damage village roads and cover the sand load with tarpaulin. Also, they should take care of road safety and maintain speed limit of vehicles in the village area and the mine authorities should take all the care that, the surrounding villagers should not face any problems from the Ordinary sand

mining project and also he directed the Project Proponent to take all precautionary measures during the establishment of project by following guidelines/ norms/ conditions/ directions/ standards stipulated by competent authorities.

- The appeals, suggestions & opinions of the public have been recorded through video and the proceedings of the meeting will be sent to the State Level Environmental Impact Assessment Authority, Government of Karnataka for further needful.
