

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S. SN2 ASYMMETRIX PVT LTD., IN RESPECT OF PROPOSED EXPANSION FOR MANUFACTURE OF BULK DRUGS AND INTERMEDIATES IN THE EXISTING UNIT AT PLOT NO. 94, KIADB INDUSTRIAL AREA, KOLHAR VILLAGE, NIZAMPUR HOBLI, BIDAR TALUK & DISTRICT, KARNATAKA STATE HELD ON 03/08/2019 AT 4.30 PM.

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As per the Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, on 14-09-2006, it is a prerequisite to get the Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment and Forests and it is mandatory that an Environmental Public Hearing at the Project Site is held under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner or his/her representative not below the Rank of Additional Deputy Commissioner.

As per the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Karnataka, Terms of Reference (TOR) letter No. SEIAA 22 IND (VOIL) 2018 dated 05.07.2018 for expansion for manufacture of bulk drugs and intermediates as above in the existing unit premises and the request of project proponent for conducting Environmental Public Hearing vide letter dtd 26.02.2019, the Public Hearing was organized by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board on 03.08.2019 at 4.30 PM at industry site.

As per the EIA Notification, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board gave the Notification regarding public hearing, 30 days in advance. The advertisement to this effect was published in the Kannada daily news paper "**Kannadaprabha**" and English daily news paper "**Times of india**" on 3rd July, 2019. The public hearing notification was also issued in the local Kannada daily news paper "**Suddi Mula**" on 05/07/2019. The Suggestions/views/comments and objections of the interested bonifide residents, Environmental Groups and others located at the Project site likely to be affected by the proposed project were invited. Affected people could send their suggestions, objections, grievances, etc., either orally or written or through e-mail to the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board / Chairman, Environment Public Hearing Committee, within 30 days from the date of publication of the Notification/at the time of public hearing.

The copy of the EIA draft report and executive summary of the EIA report both in Kannada and English were placed at the following places for the references to the General Public.

The Regional Officer, Karnataka State Pollution Control Board, Bidar, Sri C.N. Manjappa, has welcomed the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Bidar, all the public, the officials of all departments and others and media who were present on the occasion. He has briefed the need for Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India and the Environmental Public Hearing as per the EIA Notification. He informed that accordingly publicity was given in the newspapers 30 days in advance and explained the procedure of the Public Hearing and the documents kept for the Public Hearing at different places. He has requested the Additional Deputy Commissioner, to preside over the Public Hearing. He has informed the public to present all their submissions either in written or orally, which would be a part of this hearing. Entire proceedings was Videographed and audio.

Dr. Rudresh Ghali , K.A.S. Additional Deputy Commissioner, Bidar District, who was present in the meeting had informed the public that the public hearing is only on the environmental aspects concerning to the project and any quires/ objections on the EIA report submitted by the industry. In this regard he has requested industrial representatives/ consultant to make a presentation in the local language on the proposed project.

Accordingly, Sri Mahadevswamy, representative of the industry consultancy M/s. Hubert Enviro care System (P) Ltd, Chennai presented the salient features of the project viz the executive summary - background of the project, Land requirement, existing and proposed products , solid and Hazardous waste management, Water requirement and water balance, Waste water generation and treatment method proposed, Air Pollution sources and Control measures proposed, Base line study, Ambient air quality, Noise environment, Water environment, Surface water quality, Ground water quality, land environment, biological environment, anticipated environmental impacts on Waste water management, Green belt development and environmental management plan of the proposed project. The presentation made by the project proponent in the public hearing is enclosed in Annexure –

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In response to the detailed presentation made by the factory representative, the Additional Deputy Commissioner, has raised a platform for public hearing with special instructions to present their views and comments only to environmental issues of the project and also to inform their name and place of the individual raising such question.

The stage was open to public for their hearing.

The written suggestions/ objections submitted to the Board and submitted at the time of the hearing are enclosed as **Annexure-III**.

Further, the following persons expressed their concerns in the public hearing are as follows:

1) Sri Rajashekar Shambu, Kolhar K village;

The industries should adopt all the surrounding villages for development.

2) Sri Raju Kamble, Zilla Sanyojak, DSS, Kolar K Village;

The industry is having 2 acres land, but they have developed more green belt. They have proposed expansion of the activity. My intension is to develop this type of small industries to big scale. They have proposed 78 Nos of employment, this is good . This industry should grow. There is no objection from our sangha. I am concluding my speech.

3) Sri Shivsharanappa Kote, Kolhar K village;

As Rajshekar Shambu told, they should adopt surrounding villages for development. This is small plant.

4) Sri Mallikarjun Janthi, Kolhar K Village;

As Bidar is backward area, the industries have come here. These industries should run. The local people should get employment, the industries should grow more trees. They have to install effluent treatment plant. I am requesting to help these industries. For solving employment problem, industries should be established. The industry should run without damaging water, air and the total environment. Even this is a small company, 30-40 people will work, by one person other 5 people will live, so that totally about 200 people will live due to this employment. Hence, these industries should grow. I am concluding my speech.

5) Sri Bhimanna Sherigar, Ex vice president, Grampanchayat, Kolhar K village;

We have to grow, industry has to grow. Our main duty is to protect our environment. Industry should grow trees in the surrounding and protect the environment. Industry should give employment to people and also protect the environment. I am concluding my speech.

6) Sri RajkumarKote, Bellura Village;

Due to these industries, people of all villages will get employment. Due to expansion of these factories, more people will get employment. There is tyre factory in this are, due to this smell is coming and requesting to take action.

7) Sri Dayanand, Advocate, Kolhar K village;

This industry is very small, but it is good.

8) Sri Maruthi Suryavamshi, Social worker, Bidar;

I can say one thing that this company is not visible because so much plantation they have developed. I feel there is no chance of discharge of effluent from this industry. The industry has to give more employment to local people. All the industries should take measures for control of air pollution and protect environment.

9) Sri Mohammed Dastagiri, Bidar;

There is no employment sources here. In this situation the industry has proposed expansion of the activity. So that about 50 people will get employment, by that 50 families will live. The industry has to maintain norms and expand the industry. For this permission has to be given. The main problem is water pollution, for this CETP is needed. I am requesting Administration and pollution control Board to take action to complete this CETP and requesting to give permission to this industry.

10) Sri Ashok Shambu , Kolhar K village:

Our people are innocent. We are showing concern to environment and also we are demanding ETP why ? any body is having own factory?. For CETP, KIADB and pollution control Board has to take action. Once again I am telling we people are very innocent you have to understand this . We demanding water supply from Karanja Dam. Officers will be transferred and tomorrow other officer will come. Hence, I am requesting to run ETP in all the industries and only industries having ETP should be allowed to run. By holding all 4 industries meeting today, inconvenience has caused to public. Many public

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have not come today. In future also we have another 4 industries public Hearing. At that time please hold one in the morning and another in the afternoon. There is no objection from us for running of the factories. Our environment protection committee and pollution control Board has to keep watch on the industries regularly.

In response to query by one of the public about the status of ETP at this industry, the industry representative informed that CETP is yet to come and this type of small industries have to invest crores of Rupees for installation of MEE. The industry representative further clarified that at present the industry has made any agreement with adjacent industry for disposal of its effluent in their MEE treatment system and clarified that presently the industry is not in operation.

11) Sri Prabhudas, Social worker, Bidar;

I welcome this type of environment public hearing meetings. All the people have to get awareness about environment and problems. This is very useful to public to know environmental issues and effects on environment. The industry is presently producing 12 products and proposed additional 8 products. The industry representative already clarified about the proposed control measures within the purview of law. Everybody should understand about environment components like water, air etc. We have to adopt the concept of one plant for each house and garden for each village. We have to ask these companies to give job to us or we have to go to other cities in search of jobs. Hence companies should give employment to local educated youths. Companies will survive and develop only due to employees. Hence, employees should be given importance. I am concluding my speech.

12) Sri Ismail Sab, Member Grampanchyat, Bellura village;

I observed that the industry is not operating regularly. It is left to them. The industry should run correctly. Further, near Bellura village there is one rubber factory and I am requesting to close this rubber factory.

13) Sri Ranjit Bhosle, Nijampur village;

I am student Air is very important for us . Due to chemical fumes many diseases will come. Further, there is factory called Swarnabhumi which is emitting fumes in the evening , so that we are facing problem. I am requesting to take action against this industry.



Finally, Environmental Officer informed that all of you have attended environmental public hearing of M/s Sn2 Asymmetrix Pvt Ltd., and heard the environmental management plan of the industry. He informed that the opinions of the public have been videographed and proceedings will be forwarded to Ministry of Environment & Forest for further action. He thanked all the public who have attended the public hearing and said that they are concluding this Environment Public hearing meeting.
