The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, in its fourth Amendment to the Plastic Waste Management Rules, dated February 16, 2022, notified 'Guidelines on Extended Producer Responsibility for Plastic Packaging' in the Schedule II of the Rules. The EPR Portal for Plastic Packaging provides provision for registration of PIBOs/ PWP in accordance with the notified EPR Guidelines. This portal commenced operation in April 2022 with two modules for registration of PIBOs (Module 1) and PWP (Module 2) respectively. Module 1 of the Portal has been upgraded to Module 1 A. The key features of Module IA include the following:

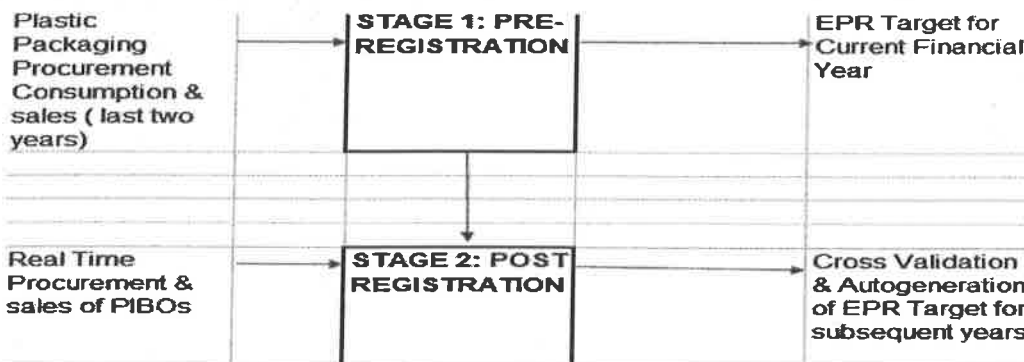
- Real time Capture of Procurement /Sales of Plastic Packaging Cross-validation of Transactions between PIBOs/PWP (Invoice No. generation / Auto-population of Sales/ Procurement detail)
- Dynamic fixing of Annual EPR Target as per EPR Guidelines (Auto-generation of next year EPR target)
- Assessment of use of recycled plastic/reuse (Cat I rigid plastic)
- EPR credits
- Facilitating error free filing of Application

(Cross validation of input data/ Integration of APIs/ Late fee mechanism)

PIBOs at the time of filing application shall provide the details related to plastic packaging sales, consumption as well as procurement, The EPR target for the current operational year is calculated on the basis of information for the last two years submitted with the Application.— in accordance with provision of the EPR Guidelines in , For subsequent years, PIBOs shall be required to provide real-time information of sales & procurement, on the basis of which EPR target shall be auto-generated as per EPR Guidelines.

Further provision has been made to assess the quantity of recycled plastic used as well as that of reuse of Cat I plastic packaging. EPR credits for the same can be generated / carried forward by the PIBOs as per requirement in accordance with provision of EPR Guidelines

The information flow for Module IA is given in Figure 1.0



The Module IA comprises of two Stages

Stage 1(Pre-registration): It covers operations prior to registration and includes Sign up & submission of Application for Registration

Stage 2(Post Registration): It covers operations to be carried out post Registration including providing real time information of procurement & sales. Validation of transactions between PIBOs/PWP, assessment of the quantity of recycled plastic used as well as that of reuse of Cat I plastic packaging, is done on the basis of the real time data.

In this regard, the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board has received 178 applications under producer category in CPCB centralized EPR portal and issued registration certificate for 141 units.

CPCB has upgraded module I to module I(A) and is in the process of migrating information's of PIBO's from module I to Module I(A) and module III for generation and transfer of certificate by registered PWPs.

The changes made in the module I(A) is circulated for your reference and informed to use and upgrade information in the said module I(A) for Real time Capture of Procurement /Sales of Plastic Packaging, Cross-validation of Transactions between PIBOs/PWPs (Invoice No. generation / Auto-population of Sales/ Procurement detail), Dynamic fixing of Annual EPR Target as per EPR Guidelines (Auto-generation of next year EPR target), Assessment of use of recycled plastic/reuse (Cat I rigid plastic) and EPR credits.
