The Central Pollution Control Board had issued directions under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 vide reference (1) for re-categorization of industrial sectors into Red, Orange, Green and White categories.

Accordingly, Board has notified the re-categorization of industries/organizations/ activities into Red, Orange, Green and White categories vide reference (2) and subsequent addendums were issued based on the requirement and recommendation by Regional Officers vide reference (3) (4) (5)(6)(7)(8)(9)(11)&(12).

Now, proposals were received from different Regional Officers of Chitradurga, Kolar & Peenya on certain activities/industries which do not find place in the notified list. The proposals were reviewed after assigning weightage by following the procedure laid down by CPCB recategorisation of industries and these proposals were discussed in the Technical

CPCB recategorisation of industries and these proposals were discussed in the Technical committee meeting held on 10.11.2020 and the committee after detailed deliberation and verification of weightage given, has recommended to include these activities in the notified list vide reference(13).

Further in the 204th Board meeting held on 21.05.2016, the Board has authorized Chairman to notify such revised/modified re-categorisation of industrial sectors. Accordingly the Addendum 9 is being issued, including the industrial sectors as recommended by respective Regional Officers and are herein to be included in the notified list cited at reference(2).

In respect of agenda 4 &5 submitted by Regional Officer, Peenya it was resolved to consider based on the quantum of sewage generation and the capacity of Power Plant.

In respect of Agenda No. 5, i.e. M/s Rao Traders, for collection of paper and card board scrap and also bailing in hydraulic machines, it was discussed that under the Hazardous wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) rules 2016, the generator is required to dispose off the Hazardous and other waste as defined under the rules, to the actual user and also shall make entry in the passbook, before handing over the waste to the actual user is mandatory for other than disposal purpose. The collection, bailing does not come under the purview of 'Actual User' and the activity is in violation of the regulation. Hence, it was resolved not to include such activity under the Categorisation list.
